Based in Izmir, Yem-Vit generates annual revenues of approximately €15 million and employs around fifty people.**

Established in Turkey since 2019 through its subsidiary CCPA Turkey, specialized in ruminant nutrition, CCPA Group is taking a new step in its development. The integration of Yem-Vit strengthens the Group's position in the Turkish market and provides access to the poultry segment, a growing market.

This partnership gives Yem-Vit access to CCPA Group's expertise in nutrition, formulation, and digital services, as well as to its innovative solutions based on phyto-expertise and organic acids. These contributions will enable Yem-Vit to enrich its offering with value-added solutions, enhancing the competitiveness of its customers - feed manufacturers, integrators, and farmers - while promoting more sustainable production.
